Budget Variation – further costs for feasibility study – village pavilion

Tree Survey – Review and progress for actions to be carried out in Autumn 2026. September agenda.

Closure of Appleford to Sutton Courtenay consultation – Graham contractors will be presenting at the September meeting with further more specific information to detail the proposed road closure.

Diocese of Oxford and Community Orchard/Lease extension – Further costs were paid and I have chased up with Wellers (lawyers). Not heard back yet and will re-chase.

The Green –on hold until Morrells have sold the property on the Green and the sale has completed.

Repairs/maintenance:

- Dog waste bin – now relocated – PetWaste reinstructed to carry out collections on weekly basis. I provided a what3words location.
- Purchase of salt bin for the Burycroft (will purchase for next winter)
- Tidying fallen Turkey Oak – quotation approved and will request to go ahead with work. I confirmed that the PC would like to go ahead as quoted and will chase as have not received a response.
- Tree survey – more immediate tree surgery to take place in Autumn 2026, ahead of winter storms.
